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BUREAU OF BUREAU MANAGEMENT ANNOUNCES OREGON'S NEWEST GOVERNMENT AGENCY: THE DEPARTMENT OF MORE

Angela Plowhead launches satirical campaign asking a serious question after 40 years of one-party rule: Why is the answer always more?

SALEM, Ore. · The Bureau of Bureau Management is pleased to announce the creation of Oregon's newest government agency: The Department of More.

Its mission is straightforward. When Oregon faces a problem, the Department of More is there with the answer: more spending, more programs, more task forces, more government.

Official motto: "More Is Progress."

The fictional department is the first launch from Oregon State Senate candidate Angela Plowhead's Bureau of Bureau Management, a satirical campaign built around a serious argument: after four decades of one-party rule in Oregon, government keeps getting bigger while too many of the problems it was supposed to solve keep getting worse.

"Housing is out of reach. Prices keep climbing. Our kids are falling behind in school. And the answer is always the same: more spending, more programs, more task forces," Plowhead said. "Enough with more. How about better? Let's fix this."

Plowhead says incumbent Sen. Deb Patterson has been part of the same governing majority and represents the philosophy the Department of More was created to expose: measuring progress by how much government does and spends rather than whether Oregon is actually getting better results.

"This isn't about doing less for the sake of doing less," Plowhead said. "It's about demanding better. Better schools. More affordable housing. Safer streets. A lower cost of living. Government should be judged by what it accomplishes, not by how much of it we can create."

The campaign is releasing two videos with the announcement: an AI-generated Department of More launch video from the Bureau of Bureau Management, followed by Plowhead's response. Additional departments will be unveiled throughout the campaign, each taking aim at a different feature of Oregon government and the culture that has developed around four decades of one-party control.
